

# CHINA DESTAINER

**No known significant effects or critical hazards.**

**Contains:** No reportable components are classified as hazardous.

**Prevention:** Avoid ingestion, inhalation, skin and eye contact. Handle in accordance with good industrial hygiene practice and legal requirements.

**Response: Inhalation:** Remove to fresh air. If breathing stops, provide artificial respiration.

**Eye contact: IF IN EYES:** Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**Ingestion:** Rinse mouth. Call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician if you feel unwell.

**Skin Contact:** Remove contaminated clothing, wash with plenty of water. If skin irritation persists, call a physician.

**Precautionary Statements – Storage:** Store in a dry, cool, well-ventilated area.

**Precautionary Statements – Disposal:** Dispose of material in accordance with all Federal, State and local regulations. Local regulations may be more stringent than Federal or State. Avoid discharge to sewers or waterways.

**Directions: FOR PLASTIC OR CHINA TABLEWARE:** Completely cover tableware with hot water (170<sup>o</sup>-180<sup>o</sup>F). Dissolve 2 oz. of product per gallon of water, depending on severity of stain. Soak for 15 minutes to 3 hours as necessary to remove stains. Drain solution and rinse wares thoroughly with potable water.

**FOR COFFEE AND TEA URNS:** Fill urn with very hot water (175<sup>o</sup>F). Add 2 heaping tablespoons of product per 5 gallons of water. Let soak for at least ½ hour or as required to dissolve, loosen, and soften stains. Agitate stains with a long handled brush to loosen stubborn deposits. Drain and rinse thoroughly with potable water.
